This workshop will cover: the absent but implicit; creating documents to enhance the development of preferred stories; developing experience-near questions; using narrative ideas in a variety of contexts — individual, couple, family, and group therapy, and community work; weaving practices together in ways that follow the preferences of those we work with; and slowing down interviews to explore the effects of different practices and to expand our range of possibilities.

Methods of exploring this will include engaging together in interviews and exercises designed to practice skills and engage more fully in the narrative worldview.
