## CONCEPT AND ORIGIN OF CREATION

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Teenagers mentioned in sharing:  
We have been to many different places, each place has different experiences and memories of growth, and each place has different memories, big or small!

### Our place, our story, our memories

Based on the above ideas, we shared with teenagers what places are full of memories, what places are full of stories and experiences. In the process, we heard many different stories and heard their hopes, dreams, and expectations from the stories.

It would be great if we could use their favorite tabletop game to help them understand their hopes, beliefs, values, and important people. Therefore, we walked with them and tried to co-create a game for them.

### Place Cards

The teenagers came up with forty-four places that touched them and resonated with them, and they drew forty-four place cards. Each card is our treasure, filled with memories, dreams, skills, and hopes.

### Narrative Practice

We hope that through the framework of narrative practice and guided prompts for sharing, participants can recall their hopes, beliefs, values, principles, and important people. We also hope that they can be listened to, witnessed, understood, and enriched through sharing their stories and skills.

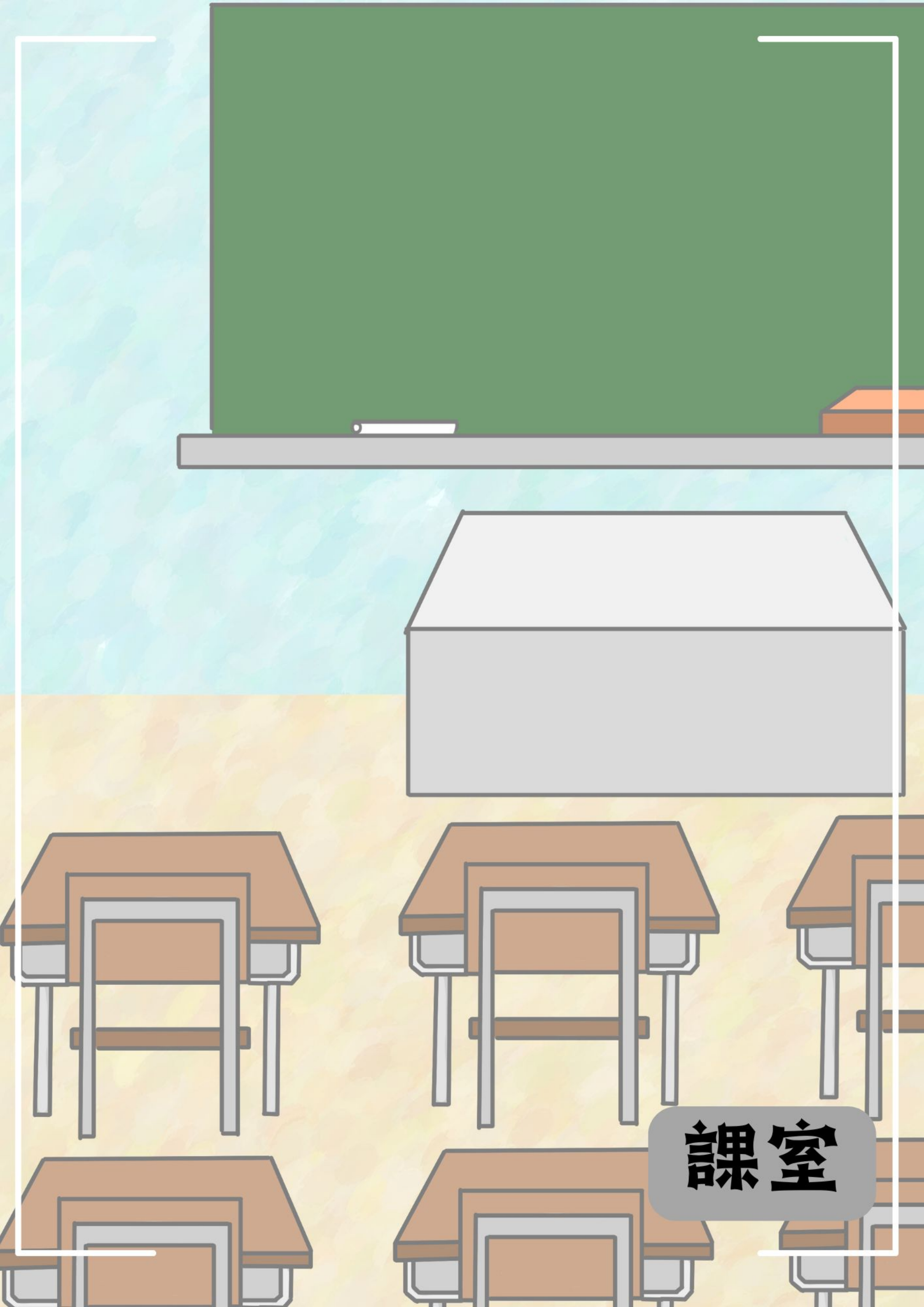

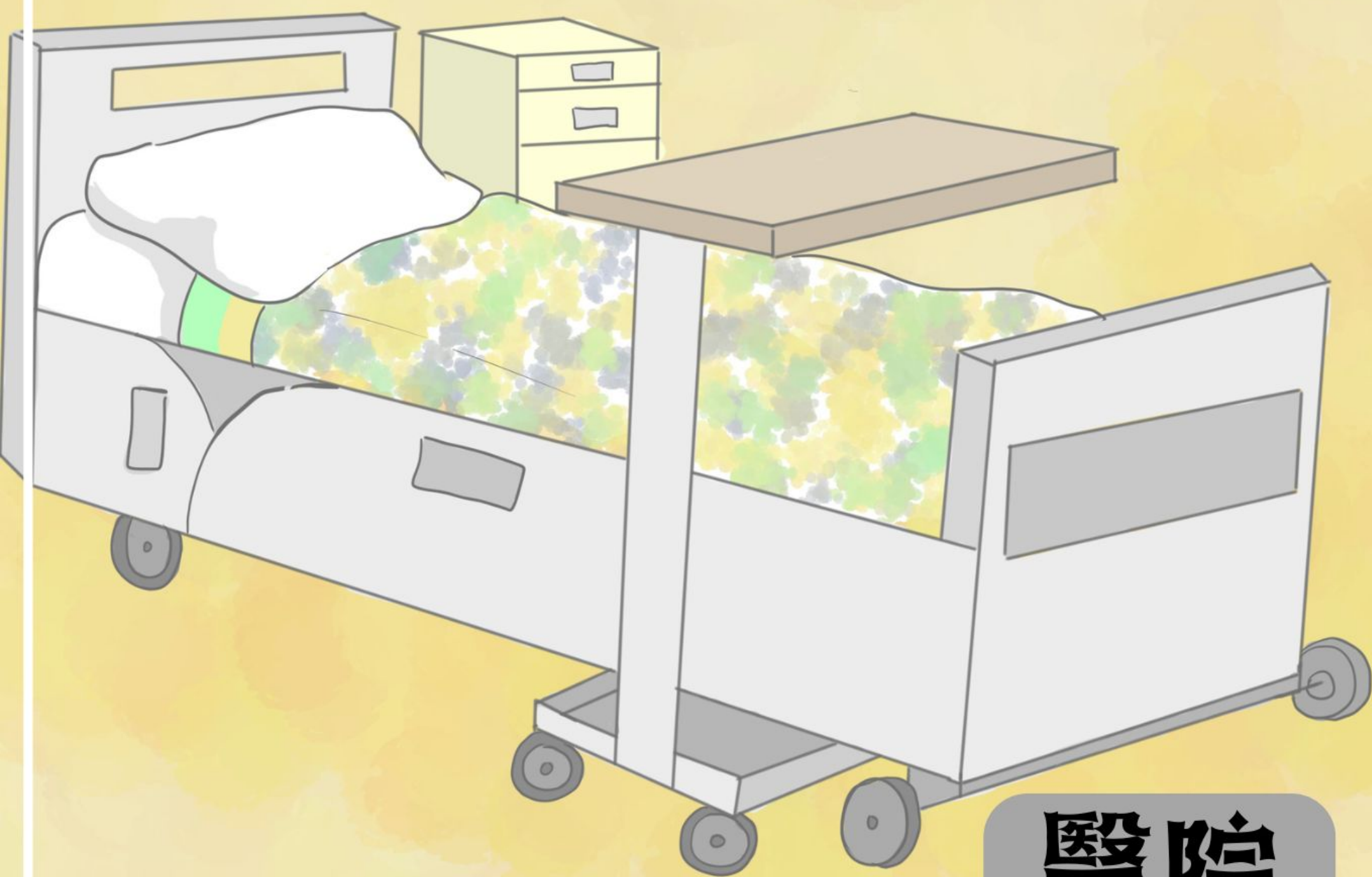
